Excursion One: Historic Annapolis Excursion

Monday, May 18, 2009 6:30 PM - 10:00 PM

Join us for a visit to the historic seaside town of Annapolis, home to the US Naval Academy, and one of the United States' oldest colonial settlements. Annapolis also has more original 18th century structures standing than any other city in the United States.

For this trip, we will be dropped off at the City Dock on Annapolis Harbor. Once we arrive, there is something for everybody. You can stroll up Main Street, where there are numerous shopping and dining options, take a boat tour on Spa Creek Cruises, tour the grounds of the Naval Academy (picture ID required--which should be your passport for non-US citizens) or the historic St John's College (founded in 1696 as King Williams School).

Spa Creek Tour aboard Miss Anne (departure times within our excursion are 7:30pm and 8:30pm and the tour lasts 40 minutes)

This cozy launch will tour the residential areas of Old Annapolis to the headwaters of Spa Creek and along the banks of the U.S. Naval Academy. The narration covers the area's history from the 17th century to the present. This is a favorite of the locals and their guests.

Beer and non-alcoholic beverages plus snacks available for purchase.
