Each paper will receive a minimum of three reviews. At least one of the authors of each accepted paper will have to register and attend the HPCS'08 conference for presenting the paper at the session. Accepted papers will be published by ECMS

in the conference proceedings. Papers should be submitted as attachments to: [valev@math.bas.bg](mailto:valev@math.bas.bg). Your submission will be acknowledged within 48 hours. If accepted, final papers will follow the format that ECMS follows which will be posted on the web site.
